ADVOCATE REPORT AND TRAINING

Amaya Henderson submitted her Region 4, 3rd quarter report for 2023.
For the quarter ending 9/30/23 (as of 9/19/23) in Region 4:

- 22 Complaints involving allegations of ANE (CSB)
- 366 Complaints involving allegations of ANE (Providers)
- 8 Complaints non involving ANE (CSB)
- 32 Complaints non involving ANE (Providers)

This is a decrease of 97 total complaints from Q2 to Q3. Of Q3's 462 total complaints, 79 allegations involving ANE were substantiated.

Community Look behinds have resumed. The new Peer to Peer aggression reporting guidance went into effect 6/23/23. There is a new DBHDS branding/logo. The statewide suicide and crisis hotline (988) was established approximately one year ago, and the call center has reported receiving approximately 6,000 calls per month. @vadbhds is the department's Instagram account. The department is currently recruiting for a Region 2 Regional Advocate Manager and a Training and Development Coordinator. September is Recovery Month.
